Session Highlights– January 12, 2010

Moment for Leadership: Pastor Randy led the Session in a discussion of our vision for Trinity for the next 5-7 years. All were encouraged to pray about this.

Treasurer's Report: Adult offering receipts for December \$24,551.00. This is above the Adult Offering target for 2009. A one-time gift of \$11,500 for Capital needs (NOT part of the Capital Campaign) was received. Capital Campaign contributions for December \$3,161. Expenses: \$25,474. The Shoreline Bank working balance closed the month at \$6577.40 Pastor Butler and the Session thanked Gene for his service as church treasurer during the past years.

Pastor's Report: (Randy Butler)

The death of Vivian McMillian, a member who was living in Tacoma in a care setting, was reported. There will not be a service.

Deacon's Report:

The Deacon's account balance is \$2143. Trinity was thanked for its donation of school supplies for the Back-to-School consortium.

The Food Bank donations in December included 1, 822 pounds. The Deacons owe the Youth a pizza party for their success in soliciting food donations. They noted that the dishwasher has been repaired. Concerns for individuals were discussed, visitations and cards sent were highlighted.

Session Actions:

- Approved the 2010 budget which will be presented to the congregation at the congregational meeting Jan. 31.
- Approved moving forward with replacement of drapes for the Fellowship Hall.
- Approved the terms of call for the Pastor that will be presented to the congregation for their approval at the congregational meeting Jan. 31

Ministry Team General Discussion:

Facilities—Elaine Carey presented a plan for items to be accomplished during 2010. This includes some painting and replacement of some toilets to ones that are low flow and work better when large numbers of people are in the building. The landscaping of the front entrance is being planned by a master gardener.

Adult Spiritual Development—Janice Ellis reminded people of the Lenten celebrations that will begin with Ash Wednesday worship service on February 17. Weekly spiritual growth options for all age groups will continue through March 31. A group of women are working on activities for women. The current Adult Study on Sunday mornings is The Confessions.

Finance—Diane Ijiohah discussed the use of new Church Trax software for managing church and member information.
